# SCHOOL BUDGETS

In the absence of a Stormont Assembly schools in Northern Ireland have not been allocated a budget for this or the next school year. We are working according to our financial predicted 3-year plan that was prepared in 2015. The Education Authority is warning of budget cuts to come but no one has any definite information for school leaders and Boards of Governors. In the meantime we are told to work on an estimated cut of at least 2-4%. This makes our job extremely difficult as we want to provide the very best education for our children but to facilitate this we need resources and people, which all come at a cost. We test your children using standardized tests from GL Assessment in England to ensure that they are making good progress in school; we buy resources to help us to teach and to help make learning more successful for all of our children; and employ assistants, supervisors and teachers who are an essential part of our school. However, all of these things cost money and in the future we may need to be thinking of ways to fundraise to pay for these crucial components of our school. Please support our school as we seek to raise some funds through a sponsored activity in June. The Pupil Council has arranged a sponsored Fitness Day through which we will reap the extra benefit of getting our hearts pumping.

Our Pupil Council has decided to organise a Sponsored Fun Fitness Day in June to raise much needed funds for additional items of sports equipment and new resources. ### PAYMENT FOR SCHOOL MEALS, SNACKS AND MILK

We have still a number of parents throughout the school who have not paid their child's music tuition, swimming bus fee, dinners, snack and milk money. If you are one of those parents please send this money to school ASAP.

Unfortunately the school will not be able to continue to provide milk in school at break-time next school year. We will continue to provide healthy snack for children whose parents choose for them to have it. <u>Please note</u> that snack money must be paid on the first Monday of the new month. If the money is not received by the Friday of the first week of the month your child will not receive a snack in school the following week. This new policy is essential as our school is responsible for the payment of all snacks eaten in school provided by the School Meals Service. This is not an essential part of school but an optional convenience for parents. Please inform the school immediately if your child no longer wants to eat a snack in school.

**Parents must pay school dinners on a Monday for the week**. If you choose to pay monthly this money **MUST be paid** <u>in advance</u> for the period, from the week including the first day of the month until the last Friday of the month. Overpayments will be credited when the money is balanced at the end of the month. WE CANNOT PROVIDE CREDIT.
