Important Notice for Parents - Payments for Snacks and school Dinners

We are delighted to have a healthy snacks scheme provided by our school kitchen which is optional for all pupils. If your child chooses to participate in the programme then they are choosing to have snacks for the whole month. **We cannot manage pupils taking snacks on different days during the week.** The monthly fee will have to be paid up front. Unfortunately, no refunds can be provided. **If your child wishes to stop taking a school healthy snack you must notify the teacher in writing before the beginning of the month or on the first day of a new month.**

The EA have committed to providing an online method of payment for all schools but until that commences we would remind you that School Dinners should be paid on the Monday for the week ahead or month ahead if parents prefer. The correct cash or a cheque (made payable to 'Education Authority Southern Region') should be sent to each teacher as each classroom has to balance their money weekly and are unable to source change.

As you will appreciate, managing cash in school is time consuming We need to ask you all to follow this guidance to help teachers in school to make the most of the children's teaching and learning time. **The May Dinner Menu** is now on our school website.
